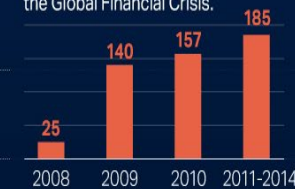

The National Research Council of the National Academy of Sciences (NAS) recommended on June 27, 2017, that FMCSA develop and test a new statistical model.

This notice explains FMCSA's analysis and the Agency's proposed changes to SMS, announces FMCSA's preview of the proposed changes, and requests comments and input on the Agency's system to identify motor carriers for safety interventions.

Your company can receive \$20,000 **or more** for various security related items and services that your company needs. Use the grant to help cover 50% of your costs!

Facility Security Enhancements

- lighting
- fencing
- securing gates: automatic devices to close gates with RFID (like an EZ pass) readers, cipher locks, proximity readers

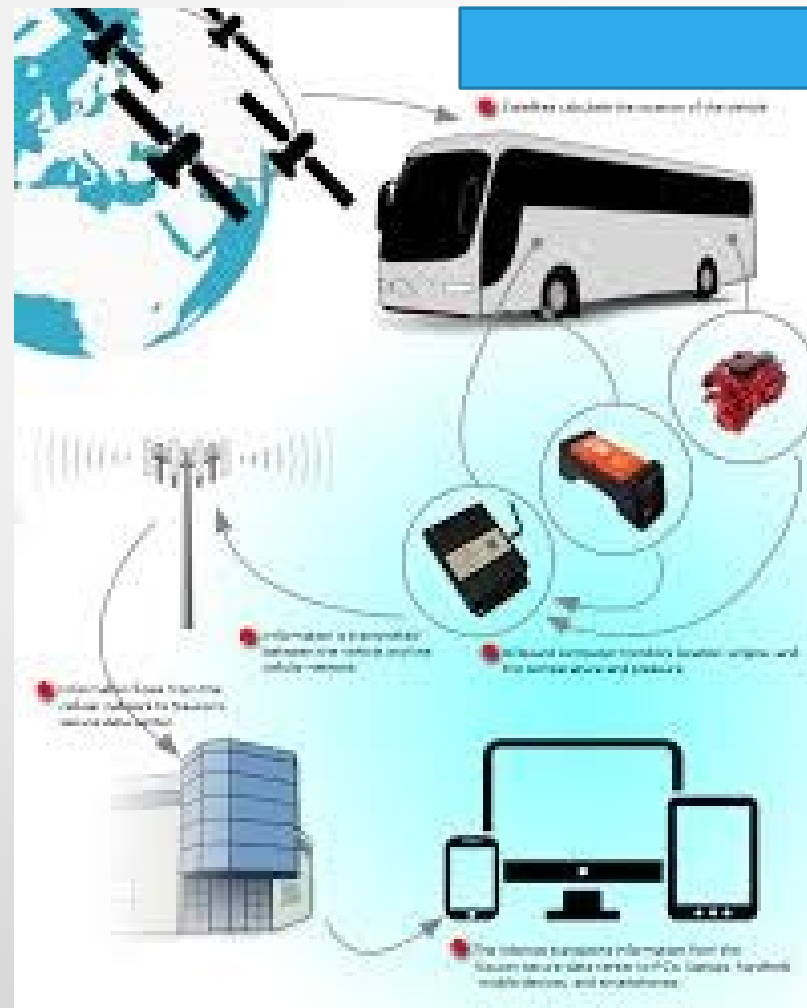
- door locks: access codes and proximity readers (ID Cards that open locks)
- security cameras (must be monitored 24 x 7 or have motion sensors that can detect motion and call or text someone to respond)
- alarm systems (must be monitored 24 x 7 or have motion sensors that can detect motion and call or text someone to respond)

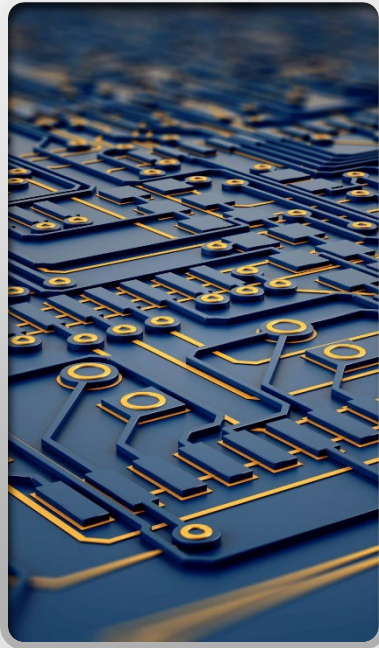

GRANTABILITIES

Security Grant - Cybersecurity



- Any project that enhances the cybersecurity of the functions of your company such as: access controls, security cameras, process monitors and controls (such as firewalls, network segmentation, predictive security cloud, etc)
- Passenger/vehicle/cargo security screening equipment

Each Project can have different parts

Facility Security: Gates, Fence and Facility Cameras

Vehicle Security: GPS and Vehicle Cameras

Training: Contractor to oversee training and employee pay

How much can I get?

We can request as much as you want

HOWEVER

Grant gets graded on cost effectiveness

\$500,000 Facility Security Improvement for a Fleet size of 2 buses is not very cost-effective security improvement



GRANTABILITIES

How much can I get?

- No guarantees one way or the other
- These numbers are a guide based on experience
- Minimum around \$20,000 maximum \$250,000
- Depends on Fleet size use about \$2,500 per bus
- 10 buses = \$25,000 budget
- 100 buses = \$250,000 budget

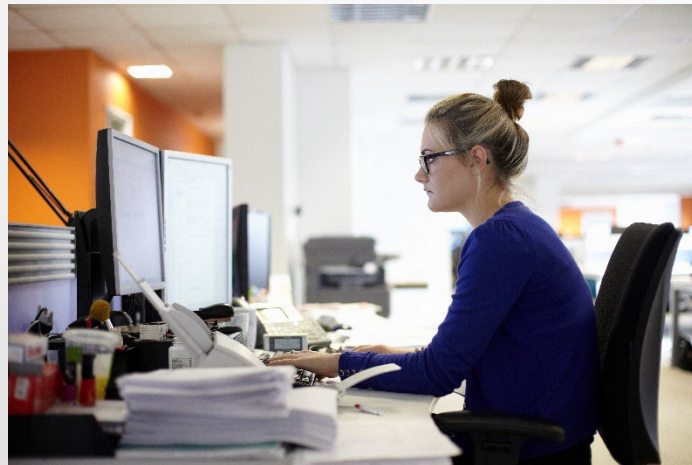

Unique Entity ID (UEI)

1. New identifying system started April 4th 2022
2. Applicants are automatically assigned a UEI through SAM.gov. If you had an active SAM account through April 3, 2022 you were automatically assigned a UEI



- Register with the System for Award Management (SAM): *Payments are contingent on the information submitted by the applicant in SAM* to register go to <https://www.sam.gov>.

NOTES

1. If you need assistance registering with SAM, please go to <https://www.fsd.gov> or call 1-866-606-8220.
2. If your company has had a DUNS number issued before 2014 it means you were registered in the CCR (Central Contracting Registry). SAM (System for Award Management) is basically the new CCR. You must create a user account in SAM and then you will be able to migrate your company's information over to SAM from CCR. it is explained on the sight. Once the information has migrated you can update the information
3. **Caution: Be aware of sites that charge a fee to help with SAM. There is no charge to register.**

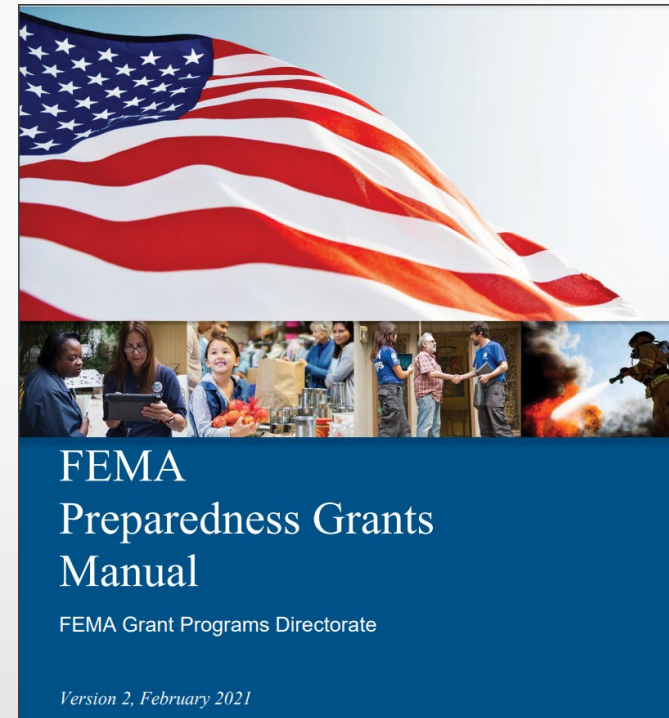
Follow Guidance in Grant Application Kit (About 50 pages in pamphlets)

The Department of Homeland Security (DHS)
Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO)
Fiscal Year 2021 Intercity Bus Security Grant Program

NOTE: If you are going to apply for this funding opportunity and have not obtained an Employer Identification Number (EIN), a Data Universal Numbering System (DUNS) number, are not currently registered in the System for Award Management (SAM), or your SAM registration is not active, please take immediate action to obtain an EIN and DUNS Number, if applicable, and then register immediately in SAM or, if applicable, renew your SAM registration. It may take four weeks or more after you submit your SAM registration before your registration is active in SAM, then an additional 24 hours for Grants.gov to recognize your information. Bus Company Owner: “ I want a Fence, 1,000 feet long, 6 foot high with an electric gate”

Versus

Security Grant: Translate to 5 written pages: Must describe the fence, describes its uses, describe its cost effectiveness, describe how it supports National Security Goals, develop a time table for installation, lay out a budget and describe a plan to support your ability to maintain the fence in the future.....

- Fees can range between \$2,000 to \$10,000 to write grant!
- ***No Guarantee of getting any funds awarded!***
- Most grant writers do not do any grant paperwork after the award of the grant

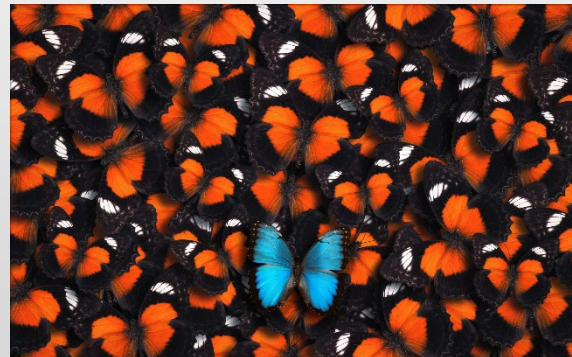

Only caveat for \$0 upfront deal

- If your company asks for too much
- If your company asks for something not a priority
- I will ask you to reduce or pick something else
- If you insist with the size or scope of your project then you must pay \$1,625 up front (non-refundable) with the remaining \$1,625 due only if a grant is received
- I have companies who have taken a chance on a risky grant project in the past, and it has worked out in their favor!

Time is of the essence



Grant applications are due by May 18

All grants completed by May 11 are guaranteed to be submitted by the deadline. Any grants being completed between May 12 – May 18 are likely to be submitted on time, but NOT guaranteed.
