Legislative & Regulatory Update

H.R. 259, Post-Disaster Assistance Online Accountability Act



Creates a new system for tracking federal disaster projects and assistance by establishing a single online repository for federal disaster assistance information.

The bill requires agencies that offer disaster assistance to submit information to the Office of Management and Budget (OMB) and ensure that data is available to the public.

H.R. 422 Anti-Congestion Tax Act

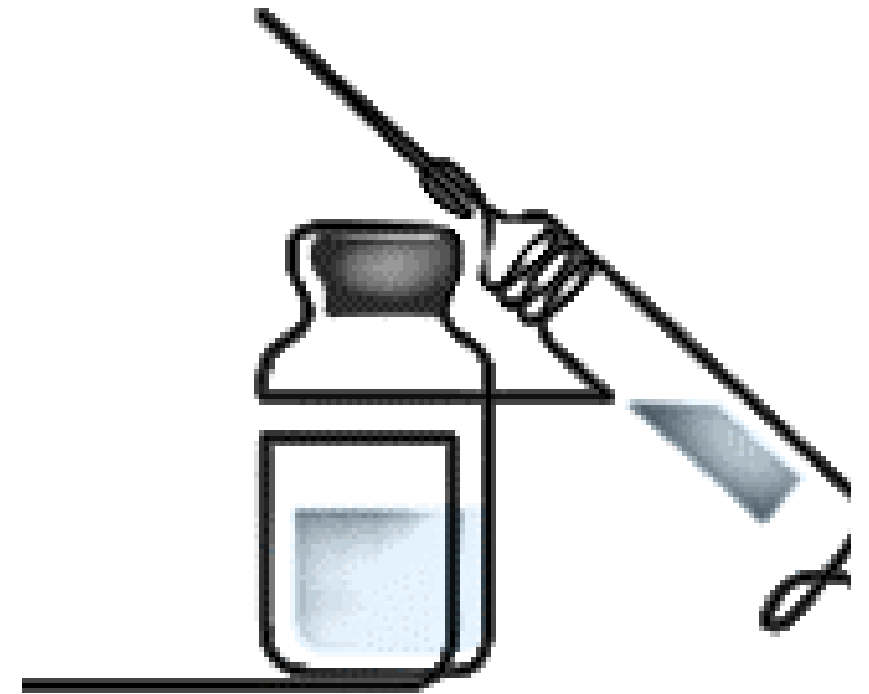
CONDITION ON RECEIPT OF CAPITAL INVESTMENT GRANTS.

Secretary of Transportation may not award a capital investment grant described in section 5338(d) of title 49, United States Code, to the Metropolitan Transportation Authority for a project in New York State until the Secretary certifies that any vehicle entering the congestion tolling zone using a vehicular crossing known as the **Holland Tunnel, the Lincoln Tunnel, or the George Washington Bridge**, or any other vehicular crossing for the use of crossing immediately before entry into the congestion tolling zone, receives an exemption as follows: The vehicle is credited an amount equal to the toll charged to such vehicle for the use of such crossing immediately before entry into the congestion tolling zone from the amount of the congestion toll charged to such vehicle for purposes of entering the congestion tolling zone.

H.R. 185 Fair Removal of Existing and Enforced Bans on Immunization Relating to Destination (FREEBIRD) Act

- Declares that the CDC's requirement "shall have no force or effect" upon the bill's enactment
- Prohibits Federal funds from being used to carry out the CDC requirement
- Prevents the CDC from ordering future COVID-19 vaccine mandates for foreign travelers
- Requires a report from the CDC on the number of visitors denied entry due to this order since April 7, 2022
- Explicitly states that this bill may not be construed to affect the CDC's requirements for a negative COVID test for air travelers coming from China.



H.R. 852 Investing in Safer Traffic Stops Act of 2023

- Grant program incentivizing state and local governments to transfer the responsibility of enforcing traffic violations from law enforcement officers to civilians or traffic monitoring technology.
- Direct response to the Tyre Nichols incident.
- Police officers over a recent five-year period killed more than 400 drivers or passengers who were not armed with a gun or a knife or under pursuit for a violent crime.
- For fiscal years 2024 through 2029, \$100,000,000 would be allocated to the program each year.



H.R. 906 -Right to Equitable and Professional Auto Industry Repair (REPAIR) Act

- To ensure consumers have access to data relating to their motor vehicles, critical repair information, and tools, and to provide them choices for the maintenance, service, and repair of their motor vehicles, and for other purposes.







Safety Measurement System Revision

The National Research Council of the National Academy of Sciences (NAS) recommended on June 27, 2017, that *FMCSA develop and test a new statistical model.*

This notice explains FMCSA's analysis and the Agency's proposed changes to SMS, announces FMCSA's preview of the proposed changes, and *requests comments and input* on the Agency's system to identify motor carriers for safety interventions.

Comments must be received on or before *May 16, 2023.*
