The BLUE LINE Departs from NATIONAL AIRPORT METRO STATION (towards Largo) and arrives at MCPHERSON SQ METRO STATION. Upon departing train, exit station at VERMONT AVE - WHITE HOUSE. Hotel is approximately .6 of a mile walk.
